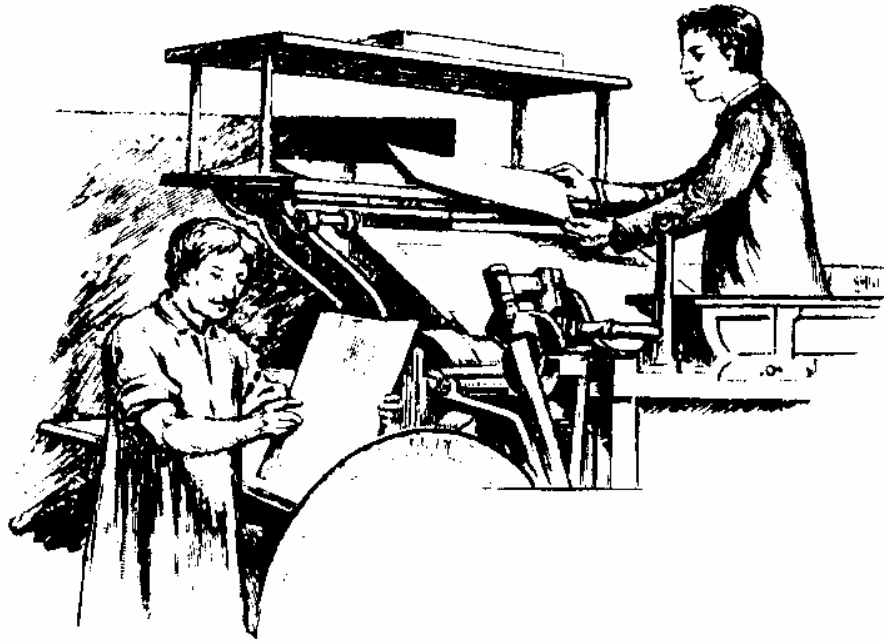

From the pages of The Prairie State newspaper, 1852.

The following names are listed as either having died or deceased in the probate records.

Dates of death does not necessarily mean exact dates of death. May mean date of newspaper recording of fact of death occurring or becoming known to the editor of the paper.

These may be buried in the Old Hickory Grove Cemetery as well.
